Dear Ministry Partners,

The orphanage ministry has taken off running fast this year with new kids already brought in, more facility expansion underway, and preparations to purchase a minibus! We were happy to bring in two nine year old at-risk boys. Due to serious neglect one of them has yet to start first grade and the other has yet to even start kindergarten and has often been spotted in the streets collecting garbage and junk. This is a sad, but very common situation here in the Philippines. **Please pray** for these two new boys and all of us workers as we strive to get them onto the right track in life; both physically and spiritually! We now have a total of 60 children in the orphanage and might be bringing in some more kids next month. **Please continue praying** that the Lord will use us to help many more of these at-risk kids this year and also for more godly, committed workers (both house parents and social workers) and regular supporters.

We're also super excited to report that we have enough money now to purchase a minibus that can carry around 70-80 children and some workers! The bus model we're looking at getting is a late model Hyundai County minibus which cost around 3 million pesos brand new, but for less than half that price we can get a good, low mileage, second hand unit that's only two to three years old (we're looking at a 2020 model currently that only has 6,000 kilometers). **Please pray** for the Lord to guide us to the perfect unit!

It's also really exciting to see excellent progress with the various aspects of our facility expansion projects. The two new rooms are completed except for a couple of finishing details and work on the new kitchen and dining area has begun and that project should be finished and ready in March. Also, ground has been broken on the large garage area where the bus will be able to be parked and this garage will also serve as a much needed storage area. Our welder also fabricated 20pcs of additional bed frames as well as several more clothes hangars; there are all kinds of things needed for a growing orphanage!

This month saw the birthdays of Reyjen (3yo) and Henry (10yo). Baby Elijah is now two months old and is really strong and healthy and gaining weight very quickly; we're very grateful to the Lord that all of the kids are in good health! We're also extremely grateful for your continual support through your prayers and offerings; we pray that the good Lord will continue to bless and protect you abundantly!
