

Dear ministry partners,

The past two months have seen continual progress in many aspects. The total of kids here in the orphanage has increased to 154 as we have some new youngsters with us. <u>Please keep on praying</u> for all of them, for all of the workers, and please pray also for the Lord to send more workers and supporters.

Several of the kids recently graduated from their respective grade levels as the school year finished, with some receiving special recognition. <u>Please pray</u> for us as the next school year starts on June 30 with our two additional teachers starting to handle all of the elementary school kids in our private school setup here on site. <u>Please pray</u> also for some special summer activities that kids will be participating in such as Vacation Bible School and a music workshop, especially for their hearts to be open to the gospel.

We're excited to report that all of the construction work on the five new rooms on the girl's land has been completed and we've begun moving some of the girls into these rooms. It's been incredible to see everything coming together since we started constructing more rooms last June 2024 and now here we are with more kids rescued and safe in the shelter and all of these 11 new rooms (six on the current land and these five on the new land) completed. Praise God for His goodness in all of this!

<u>Please continue praying</u> for John Rick's colostomy surgery. After more tests and checkups the doctors have again given him a date for the operation, set this time for July 3. We'll take him in a few days before that to be admitted and we're praying that the doctors won't suddenly ask for more tests to be done (like they did last time) and that they'll finally get this done. During prayer meetings at church John always prays for this operation to finally happen.

We've been blessed to have more groups visiting and bringing different services for the kids. Some gave the kids free haircuts, some brought special meals, and someone even conducted free eye checkups and gave the kids free glasses! The kids really have been blessed with so many different friends out there reaching out to help them. Thanks again to everyone supporting them, may God bless you all richly!
